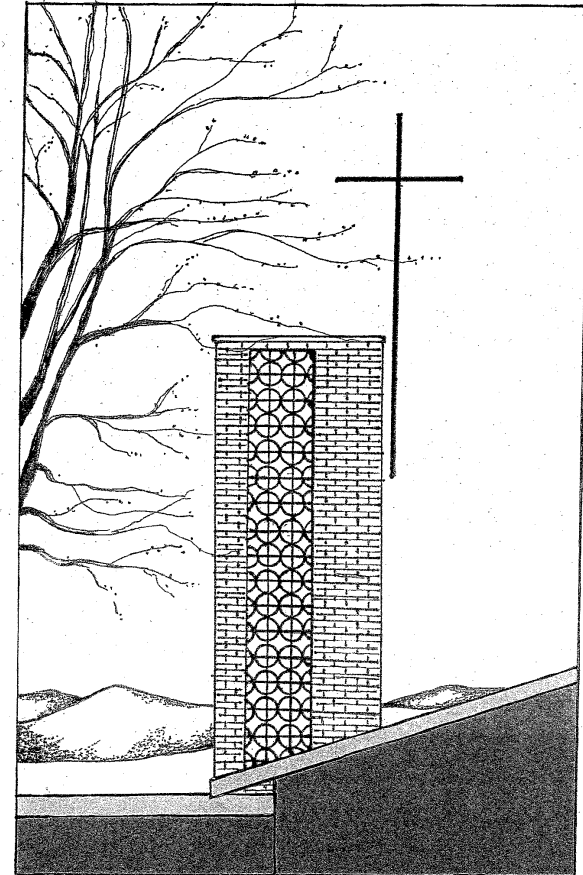

**Disaster Response** We are now in the Hurricane Florence Rebuild phase in Jones County and Washington County NC. We're planning to take the Augusta Baptist Association DR trailer down for this effort. Will you consider joining on one or both of the following dates? February 24 to March 1 or March 10 to March 15. I would like to have your response by February 18 for the February date and by February 28 for the March date. We will be able to go only if there is space available in the bunk trailers. Plan would be to leave from SDBC at about 2:00 on the Sunday and return Friday evening after work. That will give us 5 full days of effort in the area. We would car/truck pool to minimize expenses. Your donation of \$10/night will cover our meals in NC. The effort will primarily be in rebuild (insulation & drywall, etc.) but we should not be surprised if we might have to do some cleanup. We will be flexible.
